



MESSAGE FROM TAMMY ON LOGGING IN WATER CATCHMENTS

It was when I became a mother that my care and compassion for humanity and the environment changed into deep conviction and I decided that I must play a role in creating change.

As the State MP representing some of the most beautiful and pristine areas of forest in Victoria, this desire to create change took on a new importance. Part of the change I am working for is to ban all logging in Melbourne's water catchments. I have been actively working on this issue for several years, as the evidence is conclusive that logging reduces water yields in catchments and destroys the habitat of many species including our endangered Leadbeater's Possum.

My vision for our future—for my children, for your children—is for Melbourne's water catchments to become effective water catchments and carbon storages. This can only happen if logging in water catchments is banned and these areas are protected once again. I believe this vision can and will become a reality and I will continue to work with our community to care for our environment, our future.
